Regular Meeting of the Board of Trustees Kaneville Public Library District Tuesday, October 3, 2023

- 1. CALL TO ORDER: The October KPLD Board of Trustees meeting was called to order at 6:48 pm, by President Karen Flamand.
- 2. ROLL CALL: In attendance were Board members Karen Flamand, Jody Springsteen, Leanne Gramley, Sheryl Behm, Wendy Peck, Jean Blazey, and Carol Alfrey. Director Shayne Phillips was also in attendance.
- 3. APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA: Leanne Gramley moved, and Sheryl Behm seconded approval of the agenda as presented. This passed by unanimous voice vote.
- 4. PUBLIC COMMENTS: None
